

# Annual BioOhio Scholarship

## Purpose:

In 2011 BioOhio will award **5 one-time \$1,300 scholarships** to high school seniors in an effort to encourage and advance bioscience-related education and career interests in Ohio.

## Requirements:

To be considered for a scholarship, student must live in Ohio, be a senior or senior-equivalent in good standing, and plan to pursue bioscience-related studies in college. The following information must be sent to BioOhio (address below), postmarked by **March 11, 2011**:

- Completed scholarship application, including essay
- Copy of most recent high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation from adults (not including relatives) familiar with the student's preparation, passion for learning, and interest in pursuing a bioscience-related degree and/or career.

To qualify for payment of scholarship funds, student must enroll in an **Ohio** college or university.

## Scholarship Type:

Scholarships are merit-based and are not renewable.

## Deadline:

Completed applications must be postmarked no later than **March 11, 2011**. Scholarship winners will be notified by April 30. Recipients must provide proof of college or university acceptance prior to receipt of award. Scholarship money will be paid directly to each student's college or university for tuition and/or other educational expenses.

## Application Materials:

To be accepted for judging, applicant must submit ALL REQUIRED ITEMS IN ONE PACKAGE as listed below (only the reference letters and transcripts may be sent separately, if necessary) postmarked by the March 11 deadline. Incomplete application packages will be immediately disqualified from judging with no follow up. The following items must be submitted to be considered:

- **Application Form** – completion and printing of PDF form via Acrobat Reader is preferred, but completion by handwriting is also acceptable.
- **Statement of Activities, Honors, Leadership** - On a single sheet of paper (one-sided, 12pt. Times New Roman font), list school, community/volunteer, and internship activities, including years in which you participated and leadership positions held. List any honors or awards you received.
- **Copy of Transcript** - High school transcript (either official or unofficial). *May be mailed separately, if nec.*
- **College Admission Composite Test Scores** - A copy of all test results should be included.
- **Two Letters of Recommendation** - Two letters of recommendation from adults (not including relatives) familiar with the student's preparation, passion for learning, and interest in pursuing a bioscience-related degree and/or career (e.g. science teacher, medical/animal health professional, bioscience business executive, etc.). Letters must include the recommender's phone number and e-mail address and the full name of the student for whom the recommendation is written. Letters may be included in student application packet or sent separately by mail (BioOhio Scholarship, 1275 Kinnear Rd., Columbus, OH, 43212) or email (mschutte@BioOhio.com).
- **Essay** - An essay written by student applicant, no more than 500 words, double-spaced, typewritten, 12 pt. Times New Roman font, in response to this topic: **Describe your interest in the bioscience/biomedical field and how you envision college will prepare you for a bioscience/biomedical career.**

Note: The application items of most importance to our judges will be: Essay (35%), Letters of Recommendation (25%), and Statement of Activities, Honors, Leadership (15%). Other application requirements comprise the remaining 25%.

Please read the application thoroughly for rules, eligibility, requirements and instructions. *Incomplete applications will be disqualified from judging.*

All of the above items must be postmarked no later than **March 11, 2011**. A single complete student application packet is preferred, but letters of recommendation and transcripts will be accepted separately from the student application packet, if necessary (check applicable box on application form).
